Creating the Salem vision of the future

A series of discussion sessions will be held in September and October to work toward developing a new mission statement for Salem Church.

Hour-long sessions will meet after church on Sept. 18, Sept. 25, Oct. 2 and Oct. 9 to discuss who we are, what we do, where we go as a church and to set priorities for the future.

A small group (Pastor Matt, Jayne Clouser, Cassie Koch, Adam Spory, Debbie Husar and David Ball) has been meeting to lay the groundwork and will wrap up the process in October or

early November by developing a proposed mission statement for congregational approval.

The sessions will meet in place of adult and teen Re-Charge classes.

Children's Re-Charge still will be available, and adult and teen Re-charge will resume on Oct. 16.

Each session will offer a light meal — brunch on Sept. 18, appetizers on Sept. 25, a nacho bar on Oct. 2 and soup on Oct. 9.

Come and share in the discussion, the food and the fellowship to help determine the future of Salem.
