Backpack Fundraiser

Each year, Salem Church members purchase 50 backpacks and the school supplies needed to fill them. Members donate supplies and backpacks or cash contributions. We cover 4th Grade based on a list supplied by teachers. The list is available in participating stores; most of our supplies are purchased from Staples and Walmart as they have the best sales.

The Back-To-School fair is held in August. A week before, volunteers meet at the church to help pack the backpacks. On the Friday before the fair, we transport filled backpacks to lles Elementary School where they are distributed to students.

IMPACT OF SALEM'S OUTREACH MISSIONS

Every month, Salem volunteers contribute to the community in many ways—but we don't always know the extent and impact of those contributions. We will use this newsletter to share that information for better awareness.

BJ's Café / Saturday Meals: In the period from Sat, 4/22, through Sat, 5/20, **399 meals were served**.

Loads of Love: On two Thursdays—4/28 and 5/11—60 **people received assistance with their family's laundry**, receiving up to \$20 for the washers and dryers.

Paws and Prayers: On May 13, this ministry provided 145 sacks & 10 cans of dog food, 97 bags & 36 cans of cat food, 18 bags of dog treats, 6 bags of cat treats, and 41 miscellaneous items (leashes, bowls, toys, blankets, coats).

Health Fair: On May 20, Health Fair volunteers provided 85 grateful people with items.
