Pie in the Sky Drop off Instructions


Bring your pie to the kitchen on Saturday or **by 8:30** on Sunday Morning. This allows for judging before fellowship time.

You're Invited: Ecclesiastical Council for Becky Emerson Sunday, May 25 at 4:00 p.m. at Salem Church**

We are thrilled to share that **Becky Emerson**, a beloved member of Salem UCC, has completed all the steps required to be considered for **ordination in the United Church of Christ!** This is a profound milestone, and we are honored to host the next step in her journey: an **Ecclesiastical Council**, right here at Salem Church.

What's an Ecclesiastical Council?

In the UCC, an Ecclesiastical Council is a formal gathering where a candidate presents their theological reflections, personal call to ministry, and understanding of faith, justice, and the Church. Clergy and lay delegates from area churches attend to ask questions and vote on whether the candidate is ready to be approved for ordination (pending a call to ministry). While only delegates vote, **everyone is welcome to attend and show support.**
