Preparing for Ministry Together

In the letter to the Ephesians, Paul reminds the church that, "Christ gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ" (Ephesians 4:11–12). Ministry is never just the work of one or two—it is the calling of the whole body of Christ, each of us bringing our gifts, each of us encouraged and equipped

to share God's love.

This September, we take time to prepare for ministry in two important ways. On **Sunday, September 21**, we will dedicate our **ReCharge leaders** as the new season of adult and youth classes launches. Then on **Sunday, September 28**, we will dedicate the **home hosts and leaders for our new Connect Groups** as they prepare to begin in October. Each dedication is an opportunity for us to pray for and bless those who are stepping into roles of teaching, hosting, and spiritual leadership.

September also brings a chance to extend that ministry into the wider community as we join with others at **Pride in the Park**. Our presence there is one way we live out Christ's call to radical love and welcome, reminding our neighbors that the church is a place of belonging and grace.

All of this prepares us for October, when both **Connect Groups** and a new sermon series launch: *The Fundamentals of Jesus: Reclaiming Faith by Returning to What Matters Most.* Together, we will return to the heart of Jesus' teaching—loving God and loving neighbor—as the foundation for our lives and for the ministry we share.

Just as Joshua told the people before they crossed into a new season, "Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you" (Joshua 3:5). September is our time of dedication and preparation, so that when October arrives, we are ready to step into God's wonders with courage, faith, and joy.
