For more than two years, the Breathe Deep service has been a meaningful and courageous step for our congregation. In a church known for its beloved traditional worship—pipe organ, grand piano, and hymns—this monthly contemporary service allowed us to explore new musical expressions together. passion to lead us in worship throughout this season.

### A Natural Transition

Beginning this month, the first Sunday of each month will **no longer be a dedicated Breathe Deep service**. Instead, we are moving toward a new model in which the Praise Team may participate on *any number of Sundays* throughout the year, depending on the flow of worship and their availability. Rather than being tied to a single Sunday or responsible for an entire service, they will have opportunities to offer contemporary music as it fits naturally within our regular worship. One confirmed opportunity will be Christmas Eve.

I love Salem Church. I love being your pastor. And I love each of you. Pastor Matt




# Loads of Love Fundraiser
